

Winemakers Notes: 2012 Petit Verdot Livermore Valley

<u>Description:</u> Dark, rich, and bold - what else would you expect. This is a well balanced Petit Verdot with blackberry, black licorice, hints of pine and resin, tarragon, and chocolate. Nicely balanced acid and alcohol provides a soft mid-palate and finish.
